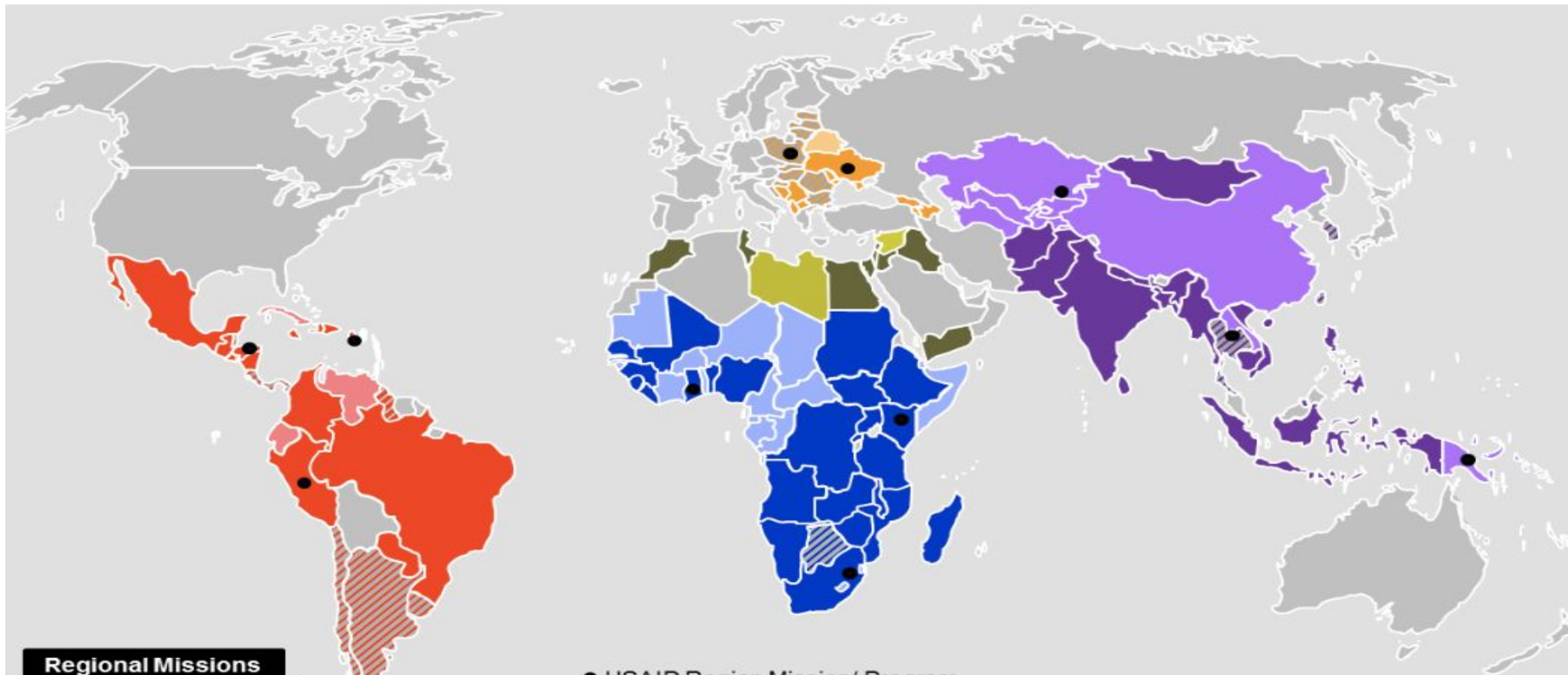

REQUIREMENTS

- Foreign Service Officers must be cleared to the Top Secret level.
- This may take up to 4-5 months or more if you have lived overseas
- All candidates for the FS are required to receive a Class 1 medical clearance for worldwide availability
- Agency must receive official transcripts from university

ASSIGNMENT PROCESS

- For Foreign Service, your first assignment to an overseas post is “directed”
- After that, you bid for assignments as part of an open and transparent process
- All Foreign Service Officers are available for world-wide assignment wherever USAID missions are located
